INFORMATIONS

LE PRISM is an Italian echo born to celebrate our 30th anniversary thanks to the precious advice received from Roger Waters tour artists Jon Carin and Jonathan Wilson combined with Giampaolo Noto. They where performed many test, analyzed the direct and recording signals. We have checked the average delay time and synchronized on the subject of a real evolution of the product.

With this new product we wanted to tell the history and sounds of the legendary old Italian Echo. Our experience of many years of work providing technical assistance to the "much loved vintage units", has allowed us to acquire a unique background. LE PRISM is equipped with most complete functions, the best musical carpets and ease of use in compact dimensions.

LE PRISM is a "creative" machine designed for the recording studio and live performances that integrates the history of analog sounds of those old models of "Italian Echo" ranging from Model 1 up to PE603 stereo unit. Offers 4 delay times + 4 selectable feedbacks, summable and adjustable as desired. The 4 delay times are synchronized exactly like the old vintage units with delays of: 78 - 156 - 234 - 312mS.

DETAILS

The SELECTOR allow you to choose the Echo mode:

- ECHO: Classic 60's "slapback echo". One single repeat from the selected head (no feedback available);
- REP: Normal echo mode with selectable heads in feedback combinations;
- SWELL: The typical old Italian reverb effect made with the use of all the heads simultaneously in feedback combinations.

LENGTH OF SWELL and **BASS/TREBLE**: Use the feedback control to create the tridimensional carpet of sound. The BASS/TREBLE control is strictly connected to the feedback and its task is to change the tonality of the oscillations. With this command you can repeat the most brilliant or darkest notes to infinity. The BASS/TREBLE is assigned only to repetitions.

MAGIC OF AGE: This simulates the mechanical aging of the glorious old Italian Echo. Is a particular modulation that acts on the echo delay. This control creates a unique effect that can be adjusted to your personal taste.

VOLUME ECHO: Is the parallel mix of the effect. It can be adjusted from 0% to 50% of the 50% dry signal. This analog mixer has been completely redesigned to keep pure performance in all conditions of use (the Volume Echo doesn't work in the "wet-out" socket).

VOLUME STEREO: The volume control has been designed with double "L-PAD" attenuation in order to reduce the stereo output level while maintaining signal linearity. The six positions offer attenuations from 0db to -12db up to the off position. The sixth 0db position guarantees the same level of the stereo and mono output.

VARISPEED

Through the "VARISPEED" we can increase the delay times up to 700mS, maintaining the "heads" perfectly synchronized with limited signal distortions. This control has been evolved to select the delay times of the most historic Italian echoes including MODEL1, T7E, PE603, leaving a large adjustment space that allows you able to achieve the maximum delav characteristics of this unit. This major flexibility, it allows us to be able to use those fantastic sounds of the past even today satisfying even those requests of the ever more demanding musicians and recording studios.

The 4 feedbacks (BACK) come from the delay times of the 4 single heads and thanks to the various combinations it's possible to obtain better psychedelic sounds and different types of musical carpets.

HEADS

The 4 push/pull button switches have the task of choosing the heads and their combinations. The combinations are four to the power of four.

Example in Rep. mode: If you select the 2+1 push switch, re-call together the fourth and third heads, it will mean the 4th Head considered as an 8th note, and 3rd head is equal to a dotted 8th. If you use the "Varispeed" you can keep the synchronism by increasing the delay time over 100%. You can also sync the unit to the delay times of the more popular "old Italian Echo" models.

BACK


The 4 push/pull button switches select the corresponding head feedback. The feedback normally involves joining the delay time with the same feedback time.

Example: head 4 On + Back 4 On (300mS delay time with 300mS feedback time added). If we want to customize our sound we can also choose another or more feedback delay times (multiple or submultiple of the chosen time).

MONO TO STEREO ANALOG CONV.

The notch filter changes the phase of the input almost 180° between sianal for its Alona with the phase changes, the amplitude of signal in the ChA channel changes in the opposition to the amplitude of ChB channel. When the signal is louder in the one channel, then it is weaker in the other channel. As a result, we can hear the simul-stereo sound at the output.

This happens via the input sensitivity thus creating the stereophonic effect with the dynamics at the touch of your hand.



A BIT OF ECHO HISTORY

The Italian Echo Units were produced by the famous Italian company in Milan since the 60s. They were soon appreciated all over the world and used by many artists including: Pink Floyd, Led Zeppelin, The Shadows, etc. In several years of my career, I have had the opportunity and the pleasure of repairing, and restoring many, so that I can understand the product well. The operating principle is based on the "filophone" magnetic wire recorder. This aluminum drum with some coils of magnetic wire wound around it and are positioned around it: demagnetizer, recording head, play heads. The historic echo models worked with 4 play heads; some models from the 70s were then expanded and equipped up to 6. This process required constant maintenance of cleaning and lubrication of the touch parts. A technical feature that saw assigning the longest time was the maximum space between the recording head and the most distant play in about 300ms.

Average delay times after many measurements:

First Tap = 74mS Second tap = 148mS Third tap = 222 mS Fourth tap = 296mS

It should also be kept in mind that the motor speed in a European main power will be about 20% compared to that America.

COMBINATIONS PLAYBACK HEADS

The minimum values shown in the table are with "VARISPEED" rotated in the MOD1 position, while the maximum values are +25%. The minimum values are with a 1% THD tolerance, while the maximum ones are 5%. However the synchronism of the heads remains very precise. The harmonic distortion ranges from 1% on the delay time 348mS to 5% in the maximum condition of 700mS.

The heads are made with 4x PT2399. well-used components offer areat above all can be found performance and anywhere in the world. The different filters of each head are calibrated to recreate the same sound conditions **CIS** the old Italian echo.

The feedback generated by **LE PRISM** returns in the style of the award-winning LTD model in order to favor those beautiful sound carpets often used in the past to compose the most beautiful arpeggios and psychedelic sounds. The possibility of recalling the different "BACK" increases the choice of sound carpets available.



SIMUL STEREO

We have introduced a new concept of STEREO inspired by the past; It's designed with a new Mono to Stereo Analog Converter circuit in full 60s/70s style. **LE PRISM** is a mono unit which simulate not only the stereophony but make it "alive" thanks to the sensitivity of the "touch of your hand" or in combination with other devices following the dynamics of the signal. The two output channels, thanks to this genius, come affected by an opposing phase shift of the signal which generetes a unique musical effect, lively and really "simul stereo".

Going back to the history, some musicians since the late 1960s explored some conditions to simulate the stereo sound in different ways. Among the best known settings, in the early 70s, I remember the DG style double stack, which provided a double mono signal sent to two amplifiers with the addition of one, or more, modulation effects device on only one of the two signals (typically the left).

CAUTION! Make sure to check the power supply connection as per technical specifications. This pedal cannot be powered by a battery.

SPECIAL FEATURES AND FUNCTIONS

The **LE PRISM** tube is a 12AU7/ECC82 and it guarantees a good duration and linearity. However, it can also be replaced with 5814, 6189 and CV4003 NOS tube.

On the underside of the pedal it's easy to see a small window where a jumper is housed. Removing this jumper activates the "tail fx" function. A careful adjustment of the "LENGTH OF SWELL" will be necessary to ensure that in the moment of bypass the "tail" is not excessive.

For the best performance the working current is 12VDC/500mA.

We always recommend a 12V 1A (1000mA) power supply because it offers better performance in the correct preheating of the tube at the moment of the switch/on.

Be very careful that the main power supply is correct.

If **LE PRISM** is under-powered it's possible to notice malfunctions on the background noise.

SPECIAL FEATURES AND FUNCTIONS

The "Wet/Out" is a buffer-equipped output that provides a low impedance signal (line output).

The connection is via 6.3mm mono jack.

The calibration of the feedback for each single head is fixed and made at the factory.

INPUT INTRUMENTS CONNECTION


The input control must be adjusted so that you can use the right amount of signal. The input level (magic eye) will help you understand how to adjust the levels.








Attention! The input level adjustment is very important as it affects the behavior of the echo sound. With low input levels the mix may not reach a good presence while high levels may introduce harmonic distortion on repetitions.





LE PRISM can be used with different types of instruments with output signals max 1Vpp and high or low impedances. The old Italian echo was used as the main PA effect and shortly thereafter along with many instruments of the band. Today LE PRISM wants to retrace those steps by offering wider compatibility even with the most modern instruments.

THE ECHO IN FRONT THE AMP





THE ECHO IN LOOP EFFECTS

GURU ADVISES

- 1. Connect the main power to 12Vdc (min 500mA). Make sure the power supply is negative tip.
- 2. Connect the "Output" to the amplifier "Input".
- 3. Connect the "Input" to the instrument.
- **4.** Set the "Input Volume". The input volume is displayed by "Input Level" and can be adjusted from super clean to soft overdrive. (This function is assigned only to repetitions).
- **5.** The bypass foot switch is factory set ON/OFF. It's however possible to set the "fade-out" mode by removing the jumper located on the opposite side to the front panel.

WARRANTY TERMS

The guarantee of the products is two years from the purchase data. Switches, buttons, relays are one year. The thermionic valves, indicator lights, wiring cables are guaranteed for three months.
